Caregivers Training Grant (CTG)	<p>The Caregivers Training Grant (CTG) is administered by the Agency for Integrated Care (AIC), a public sector in Singapore that oversees, coordinates and facilitates care integration.</p> <p>CTG provides a training fee subsidy for family caregivers to attend courses and learn caregiving skills that can help better care for their loved ones at home. The grant is capped at \$200 per financial year (from current 1st April to next following year 31st March) for each family member needing care (care recipient). It must be utilized for training courses that are completed no later than 15 March within each financial year. Caregiver Training Course Rebate (CTCR)	<p>The Caregiver Training Course Rebate (CTCR) is administered by Singapore Caregiver Training & Consultancy Pte. Ltd. and is capped at \$500 per calendar year for each participant interested to attend any program related to caregiving skills.</p> <p>The aim of the grant is to encourage the participants (especially for Singaporean/P.R.) to attend the different caregiving skill programmes providing by Singapore Caregiving Academy; eventually, the participants will be able to provide a quality care to care recipients with a proper intervention after the training.</p> <p>The CTCR is free / exempted for Means – Test or Income Declaration.
