<b>Caregivers Training Grant (CTG)</b>	<p><b>Caregivers Training Grant (CTG)</b> is administered by the Agency for Integrated Care, a public sector in Singapore that oversees, coordinates &amp; facilitates care integration. CTG provides a training fee subsidy for family caregivers to attend courses and learn caregiving skills that can help better care for their loved ones at home. The grant is capped at <b>\$200</b> per financial year (from current 1<sup>st</sup> April to next following year 31<sup>st</sup> March) for each family member needing care (care recipient). <b>Caregiver Training Course Rebate (CTCR)</b>	<p>The <b>Caregiver Training Course Rebate (CTCR)</b> is administered by <b>Singapore Caregiver Training &amp; Consultancy Pte. Ltd.</b> and is capped at <b>\$1000</b> per calendar year for each participant interested in attend any program related to caregiving skills either own interest or caring for relatives or family members</p> <p>The aim of the grant is to encourage the participants (especially for Singaporean/P.R.) to attend the different caregiving skill programmes providing by Singapore Caregiving Academy; eventually, the participants will be able to provide a quality care to care recipients with a proper intervention after the training.</p> <p>The CTCR is exempted for Means – Test or Income Declaration.
