Caregiver Training Course Rebate (CTCR) is administrated by **Singapore Caregiver Training & Consultancy Pte. Ltd.** and is capped at **\$1000** per calendar year for each participant interested in attending any program related to caregiving skills either own interest or caring for relatives or family members
